

## Ebooks Now Available through the Library!

North Grenville Public Library is proud to announce that ebooks are now available to check out. You can do this provided you have the right compatible device, a library card, a computer or smartphone device, as well as an internet connection. However you will have to download a software program, Adobe Digital Edition, to be able to put the ebooks on the device that you are using, but don't worry this software program is free and easy to use. This free downloadable software is available to download on the OLS download centre website ( <http://downloadcentre.library.on.ca> also accessible through the Library website at [www.ngpl.ca](http://www.ngpl.ca) , all you need to do is follow the set up, create an account and download. This is also where you will be able to browse the ebook selections, check out and place holds.

Here is a list of the compatible devices that will properly display your ebook: Windows Desktop, Laptops, Netbooks with Windows 7, Vista, XP SP2, and Windows 2000 SP4. Mac desktops, laptops with MAC OS v10.6, v10.5 and v10.4.10. The Barnes and Noble NOOK, Barnes and Noble NOOKcolour, Barnes and Noble NOOK Wi-Fi, Literati Reader, Sony Readers, Kobo eReader, Pandigital Novel and select Androids and Apple Devices. Also available on the OLS download Centre website are Help Links which has a list of FAQ's, a Quick start guide which will help you get started checking out books and using your device, Guided Tour: a self paced guide that will help you check out, browse and download. Another thing to remember if you are still having trouble navigating, downloading or viewing your ebooks the staff at your library are all trained and qualified to help you with any questions you may have.

Since users are asked to create their own individual accounts for the Adobe digital edition it is also important to know that although this service is available through your library you will not be able to download and put ebooks on your device using the library computers. It has to be done using your own personal computer and account. If you have a laptop computer you are more than welcome to come to the library and use the wireless internet service provided at the South Gower branch as well as Burritts Rapids branch to download ebooks and put them on your device. But again you are not able to download ebooks and put them on your device using the library computers.
